Abstracts

Abstracts should be typed on a single A4 page using the abstract template which can be downloaded from the AINSE website on the conference page. Abstracts should be submitted by email to anise@ansto.gov.au and should have an accompanying note detailing the address of the communicating author and preference for oral or poster presentation.

Flights and Accommodation

For delegates from far North Queensland, NT, WA, and NZ arrival may need to be arranged on the day prior to the conference start date, depending on flight availability.

If you are not from an AINSE member organisation, AINSE can organize accommodation but all charges including room will be at your expense. You must pay for your accommodation direct to the hotel / motel.
