## IAEA Science Chief to give Talk at ANSTO

Tomorrow, the International Atomic Energy Agency's (IAEA) Deputy Director General for Nuclear Science and Applications, Professor Werner Burkart, will give a talk entitled 'Nuclear Solutions for a World in Need.'

As well as its well-known roles in combating nuclear proliferation and supporting nuclear safety, the IAEA also assists its member states in acquiring peaceful nuclear technologies and know-how that reveal the atom to be a powerful ally in the pursuit of a better quality of life. His talk outlines how this is done.
