The climate of Perth is mediterranean all year round. The weather is fine and sunny with short, mild winters making the outdoors an important part of life.

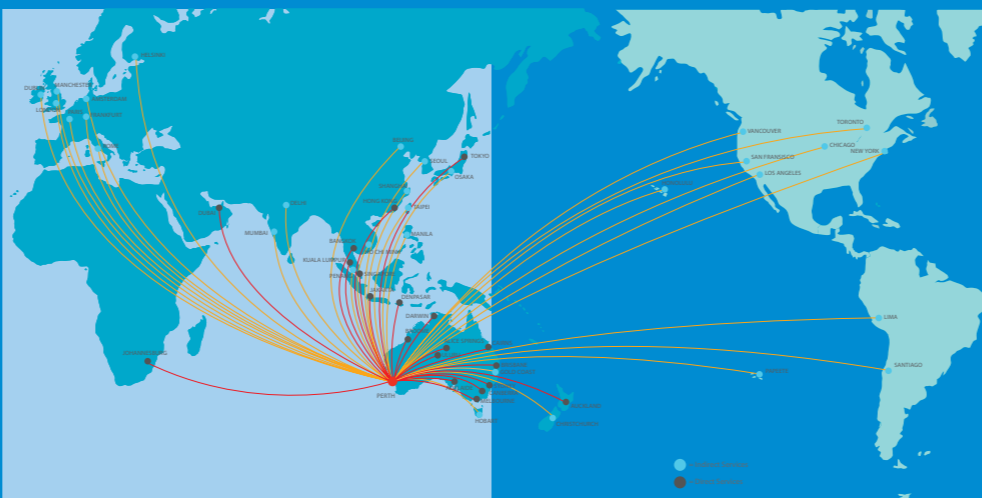
