- The recipient's travel and accommodation costs, and/or registration fee, for a conference, workshop, or symposium at which the recipient is presenting a poster or oral presentation, on which the nominated primary ANSTO collaborator is listed as a co-author, concerning the research arising from the recipient's approved ECRG;
- Carer requirements, including costs relating to childcare, respite, and support of dependents;
- Publication fees and printing costs, capped at A\$1,000 excluding GST; and
- The purchase of laboratory consumables, capped at A\$5,000 excluding GST.

The grant amount cannot be spent on facility access costs or service costs, and cannot be spent on meal costs.

Any grant funds used for purchases deemed by AINSE to be ineligible will be recovered by an invoice for return payment. If recipients are unsure of purchase eligibility, they must contact the AINSE Secretariat by email (enquiries@ainse.edu.au) for clarification.
