

## Scholar Gold Medal Nomination Form

### **AWARD & ASSESSMENT CRITERIA**

- Scholar Gold Medals are awarded by the AINSE Council to recognise <u>impact and excellence in research</u> by postgraduate students and early career researchers supported by AINSE, based on <u>publications that</u> <u>acknowledge AINSE and ANSTO support.</u>
- The Scholar Gold Medal will be awarded to single recipients only, who have completed a Research Higher Degree within 5 years of the Scholar Gold Medal nomination deadline (with extensions provided for allowable periods of career interruptions, as assessed by AINSE).
- Recipients must have held one or more of the following AINSE awards:
  - Post Graduate Research Award (PGRA)
  - Residential Student Scholarship (RSS)
  - Early Career Researcher Grant (ECRG)
  - Scholarship ANSTO AINSE French Embassy (SAAFE)


