Female-identifying students in their first full-time year of undergraduate studies (or part-time equivalent) may apply for an opportunity to participate in the 6th AINSE Women in STEM and Entrepreneurship (WISE) School. The AINSE WISE School will run online from **28 November – 2 December 2022**, followed by a **12-month mentorship program from December 2022 – December 2023**.

Some interested participants may be invited to attend the final 2 days of the WISE School in-person at ANSTO's Lucas Heights campus in NSW, where they will attend a **campus tour, design workshop, and mentorship networking event**. Online-only participants will also have access to the design workshop and mentorship networking via live Zoom videoconference. Any students invited to attend the final two days in-person will have their return airfares, transfers from Sydney airport and ANSTO, and on-site accommodation covered by AINSE.
